Introduction History of the Family

There can be no doubt that the family of which the genealogy will be found in this volume came to the continent from Scotland between the years 1750 and 1760. No date has been discovered by which the precise year can be determined. We find that one Solomon Munro was born February 22, 1772 it is supposed in Nova Scotia where is supposed this Solomon's father, Donald Munro¹ first landed.

A letter written to B.B. Munro of Birmingham, Michigan in 1848 telling us some things about the family I will copy. This letter was found in an old desk made and owned by above Solomon Munro. The desk is now in the hands of his grandson, James L. Munro, Novi, Michigan.²

Shelbourne October 9, 1848

Dear and respected cousin - your letter on the 7th September which gave me and our relation much satisfaction, to hear from you. I received two letter from uncle Solomon since my father has been dead the first I answered stating the death of my father dated August 6, 1843 which he received and received a letter from him dated September 22, 1844 stating the death in his family and their names and the removal of you and Samuel to Michigan and Permelia in Illinois. I find you have not get a right understanding of the names of your relations in Nova Scotia with I will give as far my space will allow me. Aunt Susannah Littlewood is living she has had 6 sons all dead but Daniel. Uncle John Munro moved from our place 29 years two hundred and fifty miles and are I understand that Uncle John and wife has been dead about 3 years I can't say any thing more about them. Aunt Littlewood is 81 next January and she can travel 5 or 6 miles in a day. She sends her love to you and all her

relation. Now I should give you the names of my brothers and sisters Susannah. But to me John Deborah Charlotte Sarah Amelia Daniel and George. All living and married but George and have neither father nor mother living. Now I shall say concerning myself I have often thought of coming to see your country but I have a wife and 4 children living and one dead. I have not reason to complain. There have been great failure in our crops this 3 years but very heavy crop of hay this year but now our crops fail me get our bread from the Canada and United States the flower comes in to our ports this year duty free come twice I think if I had the value of my property in my pocket I would see your country yet I have made a mistake I have put the cart before the horse and have not got time to rectify it for there is a vessel come in bound to Boston and by that means I shall be able to get it in the New York mail at the date. I will give you the manes of my children 3 sons and one daughter William George Thomas Samuel and Duncan. My daughter name is Margaret. If you should get this letter I expect to hear from you and the state of your country but if I should never see you that we may be able to keep our relation in remembrance of each other I shall write to Aunt in a few days by the English mail and that you and aunt will have the pleasure of ... them together it is all the pleasure we can have of honoring together is through the power of pen and ink and as long as we have that power we may not be forgetful of that power our parents was young once but they have gone the way of all flesh ... no traveler returns and you and I will soon come to them years where we shall fade away I can say to your that we are all well comfortable. We all join in love to you and our relations. I would write more but I am afraid the vessel sail and I shall loose a good chance It may be that property may be worth more than it is at present in Nova Scotia but I expect by this time your country is thick settled I must conclude by wishing you health and happiness. Hoping will get this few lines

As near as can be learned Solomon Munro came from near Shelbourne, Nova Scotia at a place named Round Bay where his parents Donald and Mary Munro lived.³ When Solomon was a young man he went to his mother's brother at Long Hill, New Jersey. On February 7, 1799 he married Sarah Baird in N.Y. but they lived at London, County of Middlesex, Upper Canada. What year he moved here we do not know but an old paper found in his desk shows that he was there in 1820.

This is to certify that Solomon Munro has this day regularly entered here and paid the duty on three yoke of oxen and two cows agreeable to law.

Solomon Munro was a blacksmith by trade and made sharp edge tools. He also owned a large farm near London, Canada. At his death he left a will willing all his personal property also his landed property with all that belongs to it to his wife, Sarah Baird Munro during her life time. This property was to be equally divided between his children, Bedent, Daniel and Permelia Knapp after paying the following legacies. To each of his grandchildren then living the sum of five pounds. Also he gave his son, Samuel Munro 80 acres in St. Clair County, Michigan the site of the present city of Lexington.

Solomon Munro was evidently a prosperous man in his affairs, judging from the property he left and brought up his children in habits of industry and frugality. He had helped their children to home before his death.

Bedent Baird Munro was born in Schoharie County, N.Y. on the Schoharie flats. When he was a boy 14 years old he moved with his father, Solomon Munro to London, Canada on the Thames River. As near as can be learned he married Isabel Woods in New York and the went to his father's home in Canada near London on the Thames River. The first three children were born there. The following paper was found in the old desk which is in the hands of James L. Munro of Novi, Michigan.

B. B. Munro came direct to Oakland County, Southfield Township 2 miles south and 1 mile west of Birmingham, Michigan where he lived for a short time and then moved to the old farm in Bloomfield Township ... miles south and one west. Here he resided until his death in 1871. Six children were born of this union with Isabel Woods.

Isabel Woods was said to have had a handsome face and form and have been a great worker. In disposition she was mild quiet and pleasant. She was born June 26, 1810 and died when her sixth child, Daniel Munro was eleven days old October 24, 1842 at their home in Bloomfield.

B. B. Munro married Mary Ann Woods February 15, 1843. Mary Ann Woods was the sister of his first wife, Isabel Woods. Three children were born to the union and, like her sister, she had the same mild pleasant and agreeable manner. She was an above average seamstress and it was said of her that she could do two days work in one in spinning and, as a girl, used to go out to work at this for farmers. She was a frail woman not having good health. She was born on June 2, 1813 and died July 17, 1852. The father of Isabel and Mary Ann Woods lived in Oakland County near Farmington (in 1908 the Bolsforde farm). Mr. Woods took up this farm from the U.S. government. He had a large family.

Bedent B. Munro married for the third wife Mary H. Huckins Dec 21, 1853. Mary H. Huckins was born on Feb 19, 1832 and died on June 1, 1865.

Bedent B. Munro married for the fourth wife Loretta Maplet Pain June 12, 1867. Of this union two children were born. A little girl died when two years old and a son Burley Alford Munro.

Bedent B. Munro died on July 13, 1871 leaving his fourth wife a widow with a son four months old. The widow married a Christian man by name of H. Crandle of Novi, Michigan and then, after his death, she again married a Mr. Fisk of Pontiac, Michigan where she has spent most of her married life. She has other children by him.

Bedent B. Munro was an industrious careful farmer and a prudent man. He brought some choice horses with him from Canada. One horse the Rob Roy, an Arabian he raised and when four years old sold for \$12,000 in gold which was a large price for a horse then. The horse was a trotter. When 19 years old it was sold for \$15,000. Bedent B. also owned a "mogan eagle" and a "celebrated farm" horse. They were among the best horses brought into Oakland County.

Bedent Baird Munro was a good husband and careful father: setting a good example before his children bringing them up to love and respect the Christian religion. He was a great church worker being deacon of the Free Will Baptist church of Southfield most of his life. He was about 5 foot 9

inches tall and weighed from 145 to 160 pounds. Had blue eyes and dark hair and a pleasing manner. He was noted among his neighbors as a peace maker settling many of their disputes at that early date. He made a home for several needy children and also was ever ready to help the poor. He took care of his mother by her request in her last years.

He was an abolitionist and his sympathy and help was ever with the poor slave. One slave he found in Detroit, brought home with him, and changed his name from Adam Bogus to Adam Clark. The slave had light hair and blue eyes and was as fair as a freeman. You could not have told he was a slave by looks. When his old master came to Bedent B. Munro's home after him he helped the slave to escape.
